Personal Electronics Policy

Dear parents/guardians,

Our mission at Fossil Ridge Intermediate School is to ensure high levels of learning for ALL students. We try to create a positive learning environment while encouraging students to achieve academic success. The following guidelines have been developed to assist our mission and are for the benefit of our students and staff.

We ask you to support the school policy for the use of personal electronics such as cell phones and all types of personal electronics. Please do not call, leave a voicemail, or text your child on their personal device during school hours. This only increases the temptation to use cell phones during school hours and will result in consequences for the student.

The school personal electronics policy is:

- Students must turn off all personal devices and store them in their backpacks from the moment students arrive at school until the dismissal bell rings.
- Students are permitted to use cell phones/watches in the front office (with a hall pass if during class time) during the day as long as they do not create a distraction or disruption.
- Devices will be confiscated if visible to a staff member. A parent/guardian must pick up the confiscated device from the school administration office.
- Chronic offenders (more than three incidents) may be assigned Lunch and Learning or a form of suspension.
